Anson, William, Parley, Orson and Nelson.

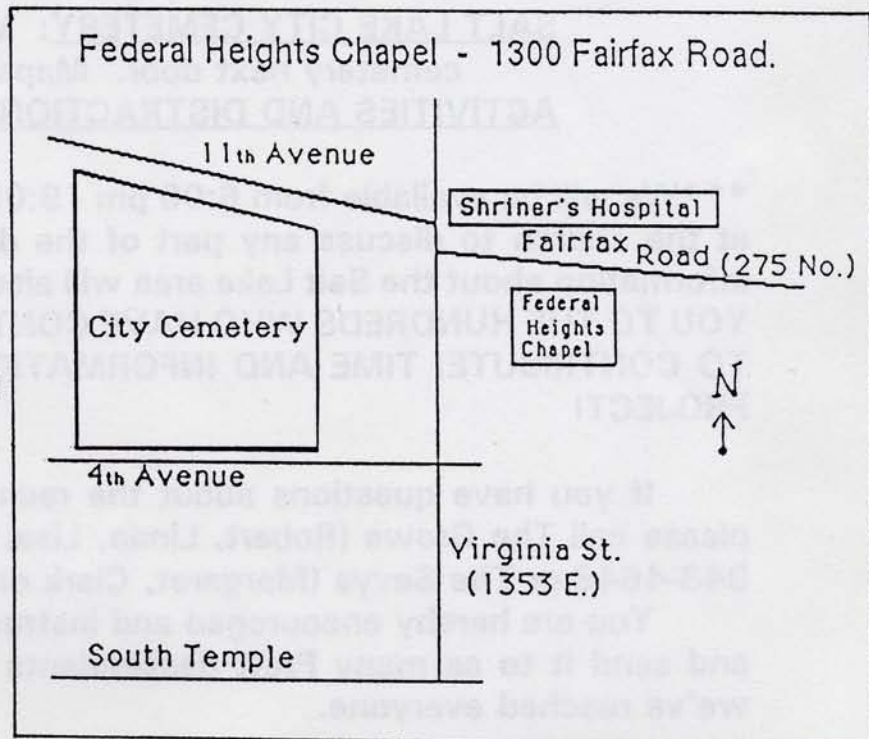
